Insulin Syringes

Sterile, single-use insulin syringes calibrated for U-40 or U-100, so the dose on the barrel is the dose in the patient.



Overview

Vero Animal Health Veterinary Insulin Syringes provide accurate, convenient dose measurement for insulin therapy. Each syringe is calibrated specifically for its insulin concentration — U-40 or U-100 — to help minimize dose-conversion errors.

A permanently attached, lubricated stainless-steel needle with a precision tri-bevel point, low dead-space construction, clear insulin-unit graduations, protective caps and an ergonomic finger grip make injections controlled and comfortable for the patient and the owner.

Key features

- U-40 and U-100 configurations, calibrated to match the insulin
- 0.3 mL, 0.5 mL and 1.0 mL capacities
- Permanently attached 29G or 30G tri-bevel stainless-steel needle
- Lubricated needle for smooth, comfortable penetration
- Low dead-space design minimizes medication waste
- Integrated finger grip, protective needle and plunger caps
